

Resolution 18-02

In Support for Senate Bill 100

WHEREAS, human-caused climate change is a threat to human civilization including California, leading to drought, wildfires, sea level rise, poor air quality.

WHEREAS, California already is meeting its previously mandated greenhouse gas reduction goals, has a renewable energy standard in place requiring the state to get 50 percent of its electricity from clean and renewable sources by 2030, and in the process of transitioning to a clean energy-powered economy is generating hundreds of thousands of jobs;

WHEREAS, if passed and signed into law, SB 100 (De Leon) will require California to get 100 percent of its electricity from clean and renewable sources by 2045 has already passed the state Senate, is endorsed by the California Democratic Party, and needs only to pass the Assembly floor;

Be it resolved that Fontana Democratic Club supports SB 100 and urges Assemblymember Freddie Rodriguez and Assemblymember Eloise Gomez Reyes, to vote AYE on SB 100.
